KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR SEPTEMBER 2020

PRODUCTION

Tea production for the month of September increased slightly to 43.41 Million Kgs compared to 38.52 Million Kgs recorded in August and 36.55 Million Kgs recorded in July this year. Production was also higher in comparison with that of the corresponding month of 2019, which stood at 35.53 Million Kgs. This follows enhanced Greenleaf production occasioned by gradual increase in amounts of rainfall coupled with warm weather conditions in the West of Rift especially in Kericho, Nandi, and Bomet counties as well as improved weather conditions across tea growing areas in the East of Rift. Within the West of Rift, Kericho recorded the highest precipitation averaging 32 to 79 mm with temperatures averaging 11°C to 22°C daily. Nandi recorded average daily precipitation of 43 mm while Bomet received 12 to 38 mm of rainfall. In the East of Rift, rainfall was much lower averaging less than 20mm daily with average temperatures of between 14°C to 23°C. Consequently, production in the West of Rift was higher by 24.62% from 23.58 Million Kgs recorded during the same month of 2019 to 29.38 Million Kgs. Compared to September last year, East of Rift recorded 17.35% improved output from 11.94 Million Kgs to 14.02 Million Kgs.

Across the sub-sectors, production within Plantation sub-sector was higher by 16.73% from 17.53 Million Kgs to 20.46 Million Kgs while that of the Smallholder sub-sector increased by 27.48% from 17.99 Million Kgs to 22.94 Million Kgs. Cumulatively, production for the first nine months of the year (January-September) was higher by 32.31% to stand at 419.16 Million Kgs against 316.80 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of 2019.



Notably, the remaining part of the year is expected to register much lower production compared to the same period of last year as the "short Rains", which commenced in mid-October, are expected to fall below normal seasonal amounts according to projection by the meteorological department. Further, significant production reduction is also expected in the first quarter of 2021.

TEA SALES

AUCTION

During the month of September 2020, higher sales volume of Kenyan tea amounting to 29.69 Million kgs was sold through Mombasa Auction compared to 23.28 Million kgs sold during the same period of 2019. The sales were however lower in comparison with 33 Million Kgs sold in August and 34.2 Million kgs sold in July this year. The average auction price for Kenyan tea during the month of September recorded slight improvement to USD 2.03 per Kg TEA INDUSTRY PERFOMANCE REPORT SEPTEMBER 2020

compared to USD 2.00 per Kg in August and USD 1.81 per Kg in July. However, the prices were slightly lower against USD 2.21 per Kg recorded in September 2019.

The Average Auction price for the period January-September 2020 stood at USD 2.02 per Kg compared to 2.18 for the same period of last year and 2.65 recorded in 2018.

Improved prices are projected in the fourth quarter of the year following expected gradual decline in production due to changes in weather pattern and anticipated increase in demand in most market destinations following the onset of winter season.

EXPORTS

The total export volume for the month of September 2020 was 48.67 Million Kgs, 31% higher compared to 37.25 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of last year. Export volume was also much higher compared to 34.03 Million Kgs sold in August and 38.55 Million Kgs in July 2020.

During the month, Kenya tea was shipped to forty nine (49) export destinations against forty two (42) for the same period of last year. Among these destinations, Pakistan maintained the leading export market for Kenyan tea having imported 19.61 Million Kgs, accounting for 40% of the total export volume. Other key export destinations for Kenyan tea were Egypt (7.71 Million Kgs), UK (4.34 Million Kgs), Sudan (2.19 Million Kgs), Russia (2.15 Million Kgs), UAE (1.98 Million Kgs), Saudi Arabia (1.5 Million), India (1.39 Million Kgs), Kazakhstan (1 Million Kgs), and Yemen (1 Million Kgs). During the month, there was strong buying interest by Egyptian and Pakistan Packers, respectively and significant increase in exports to all the other traditional markets with exception of Yemen. Other Key and seasonal markets that recorded increased export volumes include Jordan; Poland; Ireland; Ukraine; Somalia; Malaysia; Uzbekistan; Switzerland; China; USA; Sri Lanka; and Ghana.

The total export volume for the period January-September 2020 was slightly lower by 1% at 371.87 Million Kgs compared to 374.55 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of last year.

LOCAL SALES

Local tea sales for September stood at 3 Million Kgs Kgs against 3.25 Million Kgs for the same period of 2019 while cumulative tea sales for the first nine months of 2020 was 30.35 Million Kgs against 31.23 Million Kgs for the same period of last year.
