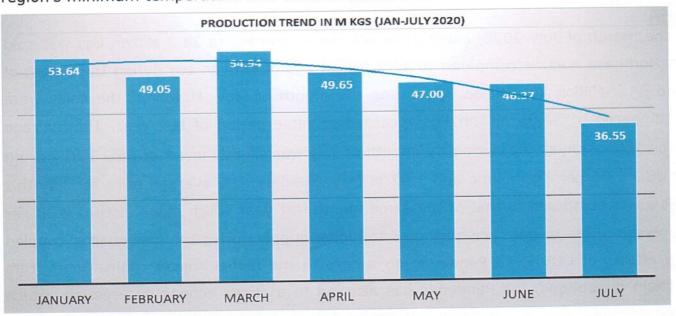
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KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR JULY 2020

PRODUCTION

Tea production for the month of July declined significantly to 36.55 Million Kgs from 46.37 Million Kgs in June and 47 Million Kgs recorded during the month of May. This follows significant reduction in output in most tea growing areas due to continued cold weather conditions coupled with declining amounts of rainfall. Within the tea growing areas of East and West of Rift, daily average precipitation waned to less than 30mm while minimum temperatures decreased to an average of 12°C. In the East of Rift, rainfall was much lower averaging less than 10mm daily with minimum average temperatures of 13°C leading to significant reduction in output within the region. Within the West of Rift, decline in rainfall was only pronounced in the tea growing areas of Kericho and Bomet counties while the region's minimum temperature was uniform across all the counties at an average of 11°C.



Compared to the month of July 2019, which recorded much lower production at 31.45 Million Kgs due to the effects of dry weather conditions, the output for July 2020 was higher by 16.2%. Production within East of Rift was higher by 25.3% from 7.55 Million Kgs to 9.47 Million Kgs. Similarly, West of Rift recorded an increase of 13.3% from 23.9 Million Kgs to 27 Million Kgs. Across the sub-sectors, production within the Smallholder sub-sector increased by 13.7% from 16.13 Million Kgs to 18.35 Million Kgs while that of the Plantation sub-sector was higher by 18.79% from 15.32 Million Kgs to 18.2 Million Kgs. Cumulatively, production for the first seven months of the year (January-July) was higher by 38% to stand at 337.23 Million Kgs against 244.06 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of 2019. However, the remaining period of the year is expected to register much lower production on account of cold weather conditions followed by dry weather prior to the onset of the "short Rains" season in October.

TEA SALES

AUCTION

During the month of July 2020, lower sales volume amounting to 34.2 Million kgs was sold through Mombasa Auction compared to 42.9 Million kgs of Kenyan tea during the month of June and 34.7 Million kgs Million kgs during the month of May. However, the sales were higher compared to 32.05 Million kgs recorded in same period of last year. The average auction price for Kenyan tea during the month of July was slightly lower at USD 1.81 per Kg against USD 1.86 per Kg in June and 1.97 in May. Similary, the average price for July this year was lower compared to that of the same month last year which stood at USD 2.20 per Kg. Depressed prices to-date are attributed to higher supply during the first quarter coupled with the effects of COVID-19 Pandemic on access to the global supply chain. Apart from supply chain disruptions, the Pandemic has also led to a global economic recession, which has impacted negatively on consumer purchasing power. the third quarter of the year following the gradual decline in production due to changes in weather pattern and anticipated increase in demand occasioned by easing of lockdown measures and movement restrictions by most countries.

EXPORTS

The total export volume for the month of July 2020 was 38.55 Million Kgs, 5% decrease against 40.59 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of last year. During the month, Kenya tea was shipped to fifty three (53) export destinations compared to forty six (46) destinations for the same period last year. Pakistan remained the leading export destination for Kenyan tea having imported 11.13 Million Kgs, accounting for 29% of the total export volume. Other key export destinations for Kenyan tea were Egypt (7.75 Million Kgs), UK (3.21 Million Kgs), Sudan (2.68 Million Kgs), Russia (2.11 Million Kgs), Jordan (1.69 Million Kgs), Yemen (1.42 Million Kgs), UAE (1.09 Million Kgs), Iran (0.893 Million Kgs), and Nigeria (0.736 Million Kgs). During the month, there was significant increase in exports to traditional markets such as Sudan, Russia, Jordan, Yemen, Nigeria and Iran. Seasonal and emerging markets that recorded increased export volumes include India, Poland, Switzerland, Ukraine, Malaysia, Uzbekistan, Bangladesh and Kyrgyzstan.

Notably, access to some markets is still a challenge due to the impact of COVID-19 Pandemic on commodity distribution and trading across the globe. Some of the key destinations that are still facing market access challenges include Afghanistan, which is gradually reopening some of its border points with Pakistan, after closing in March with a view to limiting the spread of the corona virus pandemic.

The total export volume for the period January-July 2020 was slightly lower by 1% at 289.1 Million Kgs compared to 292.6 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of last year.

LOCAL

Local tea sales for July stood at 3.89 Million Kgs Kgs against 2.85 Million Kgs during the same period of 2019 while cumulative tea sales for the first seven months of 2020 was 24.39 Million Kgs against 24.12 Million Kgs for the same period of last year. Higher sales during the month was attributed to increased demand due to the cold weather conditions and enhanced product distribution owing to easing of containment measures put in place by the Government to mitigate against the spread of COVID-19 Pandemic.
