KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR JUNE 2021 PRODUCTION

Tea production for the month of June 2021 dropped by 2.9 Million Kgs from 46.37 Million Kgs recorded in June 2020 to 43.46 Million Kgs. Production for the month was also lower compared to 45.32 Million Kgs recorded in May and 44.29 Million Kgs in April. The drop in production for the month of June follows the cessation of the "Long Rains" season in the second week of May over the tea growing areas within the East of the Rift. Though the tea growing areas in the West of the Rift recorded modest precipitation, the rainfall was depressed and poorly distributed. Apart from lower and moderate rainfall, the two tea growing regions were also characterized by the cold weather conditions.

Notably, lower rainfall conditions in the East of Rift was more pronounced in Kiambu, Muranga and Meru with these areas recording an average rainfall of less than 10mm daily. These areas also recorded lower minimum average temperatures of about 13°C daily. As a result of lower rainfall and cold weather conditions, production within the East of Rift was significantly lower by 2.72 Million Kgs from 14.61 Million Kgs recorded during the same month of 2020 to 11.89 Million Kgs.

In the West of Rift, Kericho, Bomet and Nandi tea growing areas experienced moderate rainfall while others in the region especially Nyamira/Kisii had lower rainfall coupled with minimum average temperatures ranging from 8-11°C daily. Consequently, output within the West of Rift only recorded a marginal decrease of less than 1% from 31.76 Million Kgs to 31.57 Million Kgs.

Notably, due to wider coverage of the Smallholder sub-sector in tea growing areas that experienced lower rainfall conditions in the West of Rift (Kisii and Nyamira) and in the East of Rift (Kiambu, Muranga and Meru), respectively, the sub-sector's production



significantly dropped by 5.83 Million Kgs from 26.56 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding month of 2020 to 20.73 Million Kgs. However, the Plantation sub-sector recorded significant improvement in production by 2.92 Million Kgs from 19.81 Million Kgs to 22.73 Million Kgs as its more widespread in areas that recorded moderate rainfall such as Kericho, Bomet and Nandi.

For the half-year period, cumulative production was significantly lower by 26.60 Million Kgs to stand at 274.07 Million Kgs against 300.67 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding period of 2020. Owing to unfavourable weather conditions experienced this year to-date coupled with the effect of cold temperatures that is expected to continue up to the end of August followed by warm temperatures until October, lower production trend to-date is expected to continue throughout the rest of the year.



TEA SALES

AUCTION

During the month of June, 44.63 Million Kgs of Kenyan tea was sold through Mombasa Auction, which was higher compared to 42.9 Million kgs recorded in the corresponding month of last year. The average monthly auction price for Kenyan tea dipped to a sixmonth low of 1.82 USD per Kg compared to 1.91 USD per Kg recorded in May and in comparison to USD 1.86 per Kg recorded in June last year and USD 2.16 in June 2019. During the first half of the year, the months of April, May and June recorded lower average prices at less than 2 USD per Kg, respectively. Similarly, the average auction price for the period January - June 2021 was lower at USD 1.96 per Kg compared to USD 2.07 for the same period of last year and 2.24 recorded during the same period of 2019.

During the month, "Best" category of CTC leaf grades fetched between USD 1.98 to 5.46 per Kg for the BP1s and 1.95 to 2.92 for the PF1s while tea prices for a similar category of the dust grades ranged between USD 1.82 to 3.06 for PDust and USD 1.70 to 2.68 for Dust1 with well sorted grades and those with brighter liquors attracting more competitive bids and considerably higher prices. Notably, plainer categories across the grades attracted either less interest and thus lower prices or no bid by the buyers and consequently constituted the highest proportion of teas on offer at the auction that were withdrawn.

The Orthodox tea varieties on offer at the auction had low interest from the buyers and those that attracted slight interest sold at an average of USD 1.94 Per Kg.

During the month of June, there was generally reduced support from buyers for certain markets at the auction while others either operated at lower levels or were outbid.

However, buyers for the Dust grades market were active but at the lower market segment.

EXPORTS

The total export volume for the month of June 2021 was up by 19% from 38.08 Million Kgs recorded in the same period of last year to 45.15 Million Kgs.

During the month, Kenya tea was shipped to forty three (43) export destinations compared to forty six (46) for the same period of last year. Pakistan maintained the leading export destination for Kenyan tea having imported 17.77 Million Kgs, accounting for 39% of the total export volume. Other key export destinations for Kenyan tea were Egypt (6.15 Million Kgs), UK (4.95 Million Kgs), Russia (2.24 Million Kgs), Sudan (2.22 Million Kgs), UAE (1.53 Million Kgs), Yemen (1.50 Million Kgs), Kazakhstan (1.20 Million Kgs), Poland (1.08 Million Kgs) and Nigeria (0.65 Million Kgs). The top ten export destinations, majority of which are traditional markets for Kenyan tea accounted for 87% of Kenya tea export volume.

During the month, there was significant increase in exports to traditional markets especially Pakistan, UK, Sudan, Russia, Poland, Yemen and Nigeria as well as seasonal markets such as Iran, Oman, Chad, South Africa, Kyrgyzstan and Iraq.

The total export volume for the half-year period of 2021 was 19% higher at 298.67 Million Kgs, compared to 250.61 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of last year.

LOCAL TEA SALES

Local tea sales for June 2021 was 3.28 Million Kgs against 3.39 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding month of 2020 while cumulative tea sales for the half-year period stood at 18.72 Million Kgs compared to 20.50 Million Kgs for the same period of 2020.
